

High School Humanities & History Faculty Position

As an extension of our K-8 program, students are guided through the deep intellectual exploration of content following a student-centered, problem-based pedagogy that offers relevant contexts for exploration and opportunities for application.

The high school curriculum builds upon the changemaking work practiced in the K-8 program by offering a program for [Social Innovation](#). The field studies program, a hallmark of a Sequoyah education, extends interdisciplinary teaching and learning as students and teachers travel around California, the Southwest, Pacific Northwest, and Latin America to explore the natural world and engage with a variety of communities. The high school program also offers international expeditions.

Humanities/History faculty position responsibilities include:

- Teach two sections of upper-level United States History and/or World History per term (including sections of US History, Sequoyah Advanced Studies US History, and World History electives)
- Teach a Z-block mini-course elective for 3 mods and/or coach the Debate Team
- Serve as an Advisor to a designated group of students; responsibilities include academic coaching, lessons on diversity & inclusion, interpersonal skill development, and team building
- Facilitate a Social Innovation Program student team
- Sponsor a student club & stewardship group
- Chaperone field studies and camping trips

We are seeking candidates who:

- Have experience teaching History and/or Humanities-related subjects
- Are passionate about project-based, student-centered pedagogy
- Have experience with, or have an interest in, changemaking and service-learning
- Are interested in the collaborative work of faculty, including curriculum planning
- Are able to demonstrate mastery in the field of history
